SPORT FISHING IN THE TIDAL POTOMAC RIVER LEGAL SIZES, LIMITS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS

A Sport Fishing License is Required + Possession of Fillets is Prohibited + Any Fish Caught with Hook and Line May Not Be Sold or Offered for Sale (except by commercial license) + Any Fish Whose Size is Prohibited, Season is Closed, or is in Excess of the Possession Limit Must be Immediately Released to the Waters Where Found

No High-Grading Allowed – It is unlawful to return fish to the water after it is placed into a cooler or storage. All sizes are total length (TL) and all restrictions are subject to change.

Striped Bass (Rockfish) Non-Offset (inline) Circle Hooks are required to be used when fishing for striped bass using cut or whole natural bait. (See Order #2024-01 "Revised") Targeting is defined as "to catch or attempt to catch". No harvest permitted of any size Catch and Release January 1 through May 15 No live eel.
