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Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Colonial Beach, VA — Chairman Phil L. Langley announced today that the Potomac River Fisheries Commission will hold its next regular meeting on **Friday, June 7, 2019 at 8:30 a.m.** in the John T. Parran Hearing Room of The Carpenter Building, 222 Taylor Street, Colonial Beach, Virginia. Chairman Langley invites all interested persons to attend this open public meeting.

Items on the agenda include, but are not limited to: 2019 Crab and 2018/19 Oyster Harvest Reports; reports from the Finfish and Crab Advisory Committees; an update on the Rotational Natural Oyster Harvest Program with a status report on salinity levels; a presentation of the Virginia Phase III Watershed Implementation Plan; a presentation of the Blue Crab Winter Dredge Survey; and adoption of the 2019/20 regulation for female crab harvest limits.

There will also be a discussion pertaining to the USDA Blue Catfish inspection process, a Striped Bass Harvest Report update, and a summary of the Spring ASMFC meeting.
