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Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Chairman Pro Tem Lynn Fegley announced today the Potomac River Fisheries Commission will hold its next regular meeting on **Thursday, December 8, 2022 at 8:30 a.m.** in the John T. Parran Hearing Room at the PRFC Commission Office. Chairman Pro Tem Fegley invites all interested persons to attend this open public meeting.

Items on the agenda include: The season, size, and catch limits for the 2023 recreational, charter and commercial fisheries will be adopted; ASMFC issues; crab harvest report; a presentation on American Eel Recruitment in the Potomac River by Dr. Troy Tuckey; summaries from the OCAC, FFAC, and BCAC meetings; preliminary fall survey results; oyster harvest report; an update on oyster projects, and an overview of the Oyster Management Reserve program.

The nominating committee will appoint a Vice Chairman.

The Commission will also be considering items for a future public hearing.
