Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Chairman Kenny Keen announced today the Potomac River Fisheries Commission will hold its next regular meeting on Thursday, December 8, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. in the John T. Parran Hearing Room of the Potomac River Fisheries Commission Building, 222 Taylor Street, Colonial Beach, Virginia. Mr. Keen invites all interested persons to attend this open public meeting.

Items on the agenda include but are not limited to: a presentation on the Marine Stewardship Council sustainable fisheries certification program, a report on the fall oyster harvest and the annual oyster survey; a report on the crab harvest and reports from the finfish and crab advisory committees. The Commission will establish the 2006 commercial, recreational and charter boat fisheries season dates, size limits, catch limits and other restrictions for striped bass and most other species.

The Colonial Beach Art Guild will have artwork displayed in the John T. Parran Hearing Room through January 4, 2006. Visitors are welcomed during normal business hours.
