Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Chairman J. T. Holland announced today the Potomac River Fisheries Commission would hold its regular meeting on Friday, March 6, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. in the John T. Parran Hearing Room of the Potomac River Fisheries Commission Building, 222 Taylor Street, Colonial Beach, Virginia.
