  - Reg. VII, Sec. 5(e) Crab Pot Depth Restrictions At the last Crab Advisory Committee meeting there was a request to reconsider the 30-foot depth restriction for setting crab pots. After the committee reviewed the issue, a motion was made to change the crab pot depth restriction from September 1<sup>st</sup> to the end of the season to June 15<sup>th</sup> through September 15<sup>th</sup>. The motion failed with 3 in favor and 5 against.

The issue was placed on the December 5, 2008 Commission meeting agenda and was referred back to the Crab Advisory Committee for further review and to consider all options.

- Reg. VII, Sec. 1(d) Peeler Trap or Crab Pound This is to clarify that peeler traps or crab pounds should be removed from the Potomac River by the last day of the peeler trap season.
- 4. **Order 2007-13 Two Crab Pot Licenses on One Boat** This Order expired on November 30, 2008. The Committee needs to have a discussion to see if the Order should / should not be renewed.
- 5. Topics of Discussion
  - To discuss the possible scenario(s), depending on the winter crab dredge survey, to decide what needs to be done if the current 34% reduction stays in place, increases or decreases.
  - To discuss the idea of closing the crab fishery on Sunday's.
- 6. **Free 2** ½" **Cull Ring Program Update** The Commission agreed during the crab renewal period to offer a sample of 25 free 2 ½" cull rings to PRFC crabbers who are willing to use them.
