The Potomac River Crab Advisory Committee, which is comprised of private citizens and industry representatives, will meet at **6:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 19, 2015**, in the John T. Parran Hearing Room of the PRFC Office Building, 222 Taylor Street, Colonial Beach, Virginia.

Items on the agenda will include, but may not be limited to: an update on Blue Crab research and management, and a discussion on how to achieve the remaining 1.9% reduction in female crab harvest by June 30, 2015. Issues such as size limits, female harvest closures and electronic reporting will also be discussed.

These recommendations developed by this committee will be forwarded to the Potomac River Fisheries Commission for consideration prior to implementation. The next Commission meeting is scheduled for March 6, 2015.
